Explorers Aquarium in the Classroom


The Explorers Aquarium module provides children with an amazing opportunity to learn about native seashore species in the classroom. The outreach officer will provide a small aquarium with a range of seashore animals that will be kept in the class for up to 2-4 weeks. The module is also supported by cross-curricular activities and lessons.

The Explorers Marine Class Project

The Explorers Marine Class Project provides cross-curricular themed projects and fun activities in the classroom. This includes CSI Learning about Squid & activities, the Good the Bad + Ugly Deep Sea Species investigation, as well as Turtle Talk - Learning about Sea Turtles, to name a few.

Explorers Wild about Wildlife Seashore Safari

The Explorers Wild about Wildlife Seashore Safari provides classroom activities and an amazing seashore field-trip. The children will learn about marine animals, seaweeds and environmental care.

Explorers STEAM Workshops

The Explorers STEAM Workshops can be booked throughout the year at key outreach centres that run the Explorers Education Programme. Special workshops take place during Maths Week (October), Science Week (November) and Engineering Week (February & March).

Schools selected to take part in this award will be entered into the national competition to win a "We Are Ocean Champions Award" plaque for their school, as well as a soft plaque for their school website. The winning schools will also receive some great prizes including educational books, class resources and games.
