Other duties will include water quality checks, health checks, plus training and enrichment. You'll prepare suitable diets and feed all livestock, as well record keeping and deliver feeding tours and short public talks.

This is a full-time, permanent role, working any 5 days out of 7. This will include weekends and bank holidays on a roster basis.
